OVERVIEW

The California Teacher's Association (CTA), is an organization that represents and serves more than 295,000 teachers and education employees statewide. CTA decided to demolish their fifty year-old headquarters building in Burlingame, California and build a new 150,000 square foot facility. The organization contracted with **TELADATA** to design the new IT infrastructure and act in capacity of project manager for this complex relocation.



THE CHALLENGE

The two primary challenges presented themselves: moving the voice and data systems to temporary facilities during demolition and relocation and upgrading the PBX and networking systems in the new facilities. **TELADATA** also had to take into account CTA's growth projections when planning for all acquisitions including server cabinets, UPS systems, and air conditioning systems.

THE SOLUTION

TELADATA coordinated with not only CTA's IT department, but also with its telecommunications vendor and data circuit providers. **TELADATA** worked with Pacific Bell to manage and maintain CTA's telephone numbering plan during this transitional period and coordinated with all of CTA's data circuit providers to ensure a seamless cutover of connections to several school districts and offices around the state. Because of **TELADATA's** diligence, depth of knowledge, and efficiency, CTA dedicated its new headquarters three months ahead of schedule.
